Parents and carers are encouraged to read with your children and be involved in their reading at school, if you can, and we give you clear guidance on how to support them.

Of course, it's not just about reading: Aldborough consistently achieves high SATs results across all subjects, well above the national average.

Children at Aldborough are treated as individuals. We have no school uniform, children are encouraged to wear their everyday, comfortable clothes.

They will love our modern school with lovely classrooms. They can also work together in our glass-covered atrium, known as the learning street.

They can eat together in our dining room, where our brilliant cooks prepare lovely food every day. They also have freshly baked, healthy cookies for snacks, and a drink and a fruit snack in the afternoon.

Aldborough has extensive outside space with woods for den building, a large field where children can play team games and run about, outdoor play equipment, a tennis court and a large front playground. There is also a pond for pond dipping (safely fenced and locked) and a hide for nature opportunities and clubs.

Children at Aldborough excel in mixed classes where, alongside fabulous teacher and teaching assistant support, they can progress at a rate appropriate for them. Smaller class sizes and year groups allow children's learning to be tailored to their individual needs.
