**KEY WORKER CHILDCARE PROVISION** – Thank you to our key worker parents who have completed the forms sent home on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March, a copy of which can be found on the school website: <http://www.aldborough.norfolk.sch.uk/> Please do keep in touch with school regarding your childcare requirements by emailing: [office@aldborough.norfolk.sch.uk](mailto:office@aldborough.norfolk.sch.uk) providing at least a day's notice. A skeletal staff team is in place each day, however teaching staff are only making the journey to school if required to do so. If your child does require childcare, then they should bring a packed lunch and outdoor clothing.

**FREE SCHOOL MEALS (FSM)** – Thank you to Tracy and Kerry who have prepared food boxes for the families of children in receipt of Free School Meals (not EYFS & KS1 Universal Free School Meals). The second box delivery is scheduled to take place today/tomorrow. A special thank you to staff members who have volunteered to deliver the boxes. Once again, feedback is appreciated. Please contact the office if you feel that you may qualify for Free School Meals, which is linked to benefits/family income.
